NEWS FROM CHRIS COOPER, LIBRARY DIRECTOR

Senior Library Assistant Kapa Sproat retired from the Humboldt County Library on December 28, 2024, after serving almost four decades supporting the Fortuna Branch Library and Acquisitions and Technical Services Division. The Humboldt County Library Staff thanks Kapa for her excellent service and engaging spirit she provided to staff, volunteers, and the public. Kapa has been a steady and highly active presence behind the scenes for the library. She was the last of the full-time senior HCL team members who were hired in the 1970s or 1980s to retire over the past year.

Kapa was born and raised in Kohala, Hawaii, on the North Shore of Kona or "the Big Island." She was the middle child of a close-knit family with two brothers and two sisters and more than seventy-five cousins. Her love of books and libraries devel-

oped early. As an elementary school student, she visited the Bond Memorial Library in Kohala almost daily on her way home from school.

In 1980, she followed her sisters who had recently relocated to Humboldt County from Hawaii. Kapa's first job in Humboldt was working at Murphy's Ceramic Shop on Main Street in Fortuna. Kapa was a dedicated Fortuna Library patron and when a position opened, she applied and joined the Fortuna Library team in June 1984 as a page. Her colleagues included Branch Coordinator Linnie Ault and Library Clerk Virgilia Becker.

In 1986, she successfully passed the Library Clerk exam and was promoted to Library Clerk for the Fortuna Library, where she served the community for ten years. I have fond memories of Kapa assisting me with finding materials for my students in the late 1980s, when I was a teacher at Bridgeville School. Kapa used to joke about how I had hair back then. With her great sense of humor, welcoming smile, and empathy, she had a special way of making library guests feel welcome and comfortable. She enjoyed working at the library and being immersed in the community



life of Fortuna. Kapa said, "Library regulars would bring her apples in the fall, honey from their beehives, and discuss goings on about their lives."

In the late 1990s Kapa left the Fortuna Library for the opportunity to work for the Acquisitions and Technical Services Division of the Eureka Main Library where she has worked until retirement. Kapa said, "It was a dream to work in the beautiful new Eureka Library building behind the scenes."




